



Dear 2020 Field User:

We are looking forward to our 2020 season. We will begin accepting field permit requests on January 20, 2020. Getting your request in early does not give you a better chance of getting fields. Fields will be assigned starting on January 27. We will do our best to accommodate everyone's needs and past years have shown that through attrition and teams aging out we usually can accommodate most requests.

The Process/Forms:

Please fill out all required paperwork completely.

Field Request Form – Please put your choices down in order of preference 1st, 2nd etc.

Roster Residency Summary Form – This form determines your team's residency % and fee amount. Please include names and addresses of your team members. On the Roster Residency Summary there is a link to the Clermont County Auditor's office. If you are unsure if your team member is a resident of Miami Twp. (it can be confusing) do a property search and it will tell you the Parcel ID #. If it starts with a 16, 17 or 18 they are Miami Twp. residents. Also include a copy of your roster.

Fee Schedule – This is based on the number of players on your team and the total residency%

Copy of Team Insurance Policy- This can be forwarded to me prior to your teams start date.

The Permit Fee:

This fee is a onetime payment prior to your start date. This fee is based on your team size and residency %. The fee is lower for teams with more Miami Twp. residents and higher for lower residency percents. Once you figure out your team residency % you will see the amount you will pay. Residency is to be verified on the Roster Summary form. We expect 100% accuracy on these summaries. This can be paid with check or cash.

Priority Process:

We do use a priority process in assigning fields. Returning teams have priority over new teams and new teams will be ranked according to their residency %. Returning teams and new teams with the highest residency % will be given a higher priority.

Allotted Time Use:

You may be allotted up to two weekday practice nights if possible. You may request Saturday time slots for games only. I will have two-hour time slots starting at 9:00am on all fields. Once you get your schedules please email me your game dates and I will try to accommodate you.

New Teams:

If you are a new coach using our fields and have questions, please call Miami Township Recreation Director, Krystin Thibodeau at (513) 248.3727. If your question(s) is not answered you will be directed to our Park Supervisor, Allen Leab.

Block Out Dates for Scheduling:

We do host a few large events at Miami Meadows park in the spring. When scheduling your practices or games please note that Miami Meadows will be blocked out until 12:00pm on Saturday April 25 and Saturday May 9. In conjunction with the Clermont County Visitors Bureau, Miami Meadows will be hosting the USAFL Australian Rules Football League Eastern Tournament. The football and soccer fields will be blocked out June 25-27. Also, please note when requesting field times that we have a very large adult church softball league that uses all four fields at Miami Meadows on Monday nights. We are taking Special Event requests for 2020. Once your request is approved and entered in our software program you will be emailed your field permit locations, dates and times. **Please be sure to review your field request paperwork once received. Always bring your permit verification with you in case someone is on your field.**

Field Hot Line:

Our Park and Field Condition Hot Line is 248-5513. During the spring it is often questionable whether fields are playable. It is possible certain fields are wetter and will be closed and others will be open. Please call this number after 3:00pm daily to hear updates or closings. Any organization or group found to be practicing or playing games on Miami Township fields after the hotline has stated they are closed **will** have their permit revoked. We do have someone who checks this for us. Please relay this information and phone number to coaches and parents. Please make sure all team parents have this number. It is also on our website at *MiamiTwpOH.gov*. Please review the following information which gives information pertinent to each sport regarding opening and closing dates. * **You must share our Lightning Policy with all coaches as well as the Tobacco/Vaping Free Policy** and ensure all coaches, visiting teams and parents are aware of it.

Baseball Fields Seasons

Spring Season - March 9 – July 24 Fall Season – Aug. 3 – Oct.30

Note: Fields open March 9 weather permitting, some fields may be closed in March to prepare them for the season. Preparation work begins as soon as weather permits in February through March.

Soccer Fields Seasons

Spring Season- March 9 -June 29 Fall Season- Aug. 3-Nov.6

Note: All organizations using Miami Township soccer fields **MUST** provide a field layout and goal sizes needed for each field for the spring and fall seasons. The spring layout must be provided no later than February 27 and fall season provided by July 17. If the layouts are not provided by these dates, we will assume that the organizations will not be using the facilities for that season.

Football Season – July 20- Nov. 6 All FB equipment must be removed by Nov. 6
