Snow Emergencies

Miami Township has over 600 streets. Those 600 streets combine for approximately 157 miles of roads that are owned and maintained by the Miami Township Service Department. The following roads are the maintenance responsibility of either ODOT or the Clermont County Engineer's Office and not Miami Township.

Clermont County maintained roads in Miami Township (36.16 miles total):

Ohio Revised Code Section 505.17(A) provides the Board of Trustees of Miami Township with the authority to adopt a general snow emergency authorization and limit or prohibit parking on any Township street or road during a snow emergency.

In accordance with Township Resolution #2016-64 the Township may declare a snow emergency when any of the following conditions are present:

Level 1: Roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow. Roads may also be icy. Motorists are urged to drive very cautiously.

Level 2: Roadways are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow. Roads may also be very icy. Only those who feel it necessary to drive should be out on the roads. Contact your employer to see if you should report to work. Motorists should use extreme caution.

Level 3: All roadways are closed to non-emergency personnel. No one should be driving during those conditions unless it is absolutely necessary to travel, or a personal emergency exists. All employees should contact their employer to see if they should report to work. Those traveling on the roads may subject themselves to arrest.

Any order issued in accordance with this authorization shall become effective two (2) hours after an announcement has been made to the local news media.
