RESOLUTION 2015 - 39

The Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio met in regular session at the Miami Township Civic Building on July 21, 2015 with the following members present: Ken Tracy, Mary Makley Wolff and Karl Schultz.

MR. TRACY made a motion to adopt the following Resolution:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RESTRICTION OF PARKING ON MIDDLETON WAY AND AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF SIGNS BY THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT TO REFLECT THE RESTRICTIONS AND DISPENSING WITH A SECOND READING

WHEREAS The Board of Trustees ("the "Board") has received complaints from residents in the area that parking along Middleton Way has created a safety hazard that will not allow traffic to flow along the roadway; and

WHEREAS this condition which allows for parking near the island in the road along Middleton Way creates a hazard to emergency vehicles and other drivers along Middleton Way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Miami Township, Clermont County, Ohio by authority of Section 505.82 of the Ohio Revised Code, as follows:

- SECTION 1:** The Board hereby determines that in order to remedy unsafe conditions created by parking along Middleton Way, parking is to be restricted to prohibit parking along the road in any areas where the Service Director determines it is unsafe to do so after consultation with the Police Chief and the Fire Chief.
- SECTION 2:** The Township Service Department is authorized to place signs along Middleton Way advising the road where parking is to be restricted.
- SECTION 3:** That this Board hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That the Board does hereby dispense with the requirement that this Resolution be read on two separate days, pursuant to Section 504.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, and authorizes the adoption of this Resolution upon its first reading.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. SCHULTZ seconded the motion to adopt the Resolution. On the roll call being called the vote resulted as follows:




